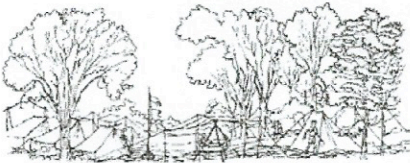


Camper Equipment List

Clothing Items

- Pajamas
- Scout Uniform Class A*
*The Boy Scout Uniform consists of the following: Official Scout shirt, official Scout Pants (long or short); official Scout Socks worn with shorts; and a scouting belt. Hats and neckerchiefs are optional but must be worn uniformly.
- Troop T-Shirt (Class B Uniform Shirt) Sweatshirt or Jacket
- Poncho or Raingear
- Hat or Visor
- Rugged Pants (Levis)
- Underwear & Socks
- Hiking Boots and Proper Socks
- Tennis Shoes or Moccasins
- Swim Suit and Towel
- Old Tennis Shoes

Toilet Kit

(with fresh/extra batteries)

(Not a sheath Knife)
- Compass
- Watch
