

Merit Badge Process

Step 1

- Scout contacts Scoutmaster, indicates interest and gets a signed Blue Card
- Scout contacts Merit Badge Coordinator, who identifies Merit Badge Counselor

Step 2

- Scout contacts Merit Badge Counselor
- *Remember to include parents for 2 deep leadership*

Step 3

- Scout/Merit Badge Counselor meet or Merit Badge Counselor hosts a kickoff or clinic and scout attends (in-person or online)
- *Remember to include parents for 2 deep leadership*

Step 4

- Subsequent meetings when needed
- *Remember to include parents for 2 deep leadership*

Step 5

- Scout completes Merit Badge requirements

Step 7

- Counselor approves Merit Badge completion and signs Blue Card (in-person or online)

Step 8

- Scout indicates Merit Badge completion to Scoutmaster and gets final sign off on Blue Card.

Step 9

- Scout returns signed Blue Card to Advancement Chair. If Merit Badge is taken online, scout emails Advancement Chair, Scoutmaster, and Merit Badge Counselor to confirm completion
